DAYLIGHT-SAVING TIME *SPRINGS* FORWARD


Don't forget that on Sunday, March 8, 2009, the conversion between Zulu and our local time will change. The earlier time change also means more evening daylight hours and more time for daytime flying!



To Convert From: To Zulu Time:

Eastern Daylight	Add 4 hours
Central Daylight	Add 5 hours
Mountain Daylight	Add 6 hours
Pacific Daylight	Add 7 hours

Ten Commandments for Flying Safely

1. Know the characteristics of your aircraft.
2. Preflight your aircraft per the checklist.
3. Avoid complacency.
4. Always check the weather—if in doubt, don't fly.
5. Know your limitations.
6. There is never a need for an emergency takeoff!
7. Check for TFRS and restricted airspace.
8. Practice emergency procedures.
9. Think ahead of the aircraft.
10. Don't stop learning!
