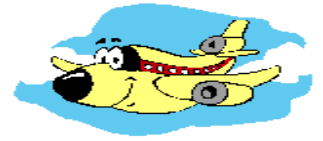

## CITY OF MARION ATTEMPTING AN INVOLUNTARY ANNEXATION OF THE MARION AIRPORT

The City of Marion and the Marion Economic Development Company has purchased the land west of the runway and are attempting to annex the Marion Airport into the city limits. This would certainly benefit the planned industrial park but have a **VERY NEGATIVE IMPACT UPON THE AIRPORT**. The Marion Airport is private owned and public use. We receive NO public funding from ANY government agency. Our airport has more traffic than most of the other public owned airports in the State who do receive public funds and pay no taxes. Marion Airport is contesting the annexation and we are still in negotiations with the city and Medco to forestall the annexation. A public hearing before the Marion City Council is scheduled for Thursday, October 1, 2009 at 7 pm in the Marion Council Chambers.
